South Cook ISC, in partnership with Pepper Construction and Wight & Company, is honored to sponsor and host the North, South and West 40 ISC Scripps Spelling Bees.

- Schools must register to participate in the suburban Cook County bees with Scripps National Spelling Bee at <http://spellingbee.com/enrollment>.
- Enrollment fee is \$175 per individual school and \$120 for an individual home-schooled student through December 31, 2021, with a \$7.50 handling fee if paid by check. Credit cards are recommended.
- Local district level spelling bees must be conducted by February 22, 2022.
- The Spelling Bee Coordinator should complete and submit the [District Winner Registration Form](#) found on the South Cook ISC web page (www.s-cook.org) under the heading Parent/Community no later than February 22, 2022 to Margot J. Fennelly.
- Each district may send only ONE winner to the Suburban Cook County ISC Scripps Spelling Bee.
- North, South, and West 40 ISC Scripps Spelling Bees will be conducted during the 1st or 2nd week of March 2022.
- The district spelling bee winner and coordinator will receive a confirmation notice electronically with the date, time and location for participation in the 12th Annual ISC Scripps Spelling Bee.
- First, second and third place finalists from the North Cook, South Cook and West 40 bees will have the opportunity to compete at the Regional ISC Championship at the end of March 2022.
- A confirmation notice will be sent electronically to our 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finalists and coordinators with details about the Regional ISC Scripps Championship.
- Registration for all bees is from 6:00-6:45 pm; bees begin promptly at 7:00 pm.
- Pepper Construction and Wight & Company will provide an all-expense paid trip to Washington D. C. for our regional champion and one parent to attend the National Scripps Spelling Bee competition that will be held in person during the Memorial Day Week at the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center, National Harbor, Maryland televised live on ESPN and ESPN 3.
- The national champion will receive a \$50,000 grand prize along with several other awards and accolades.
- Safety precautions for bees at the local, regional, and national levels are subject to change based on CDC health guidelines and will be announced closer to the event dates.
